## from the Chairs

Some conference events and sessions will be held in the hotel while others will be in the Fort Garry Conference Centre located in Fort Garry Place adjacent to the hotel (and connected by walkway). The combination of the two facilities ensures that we will benefit from ample and well-appointed meeting space.

Late spring in Winnipeg is a lovely time of year and we invite you to take advantage of the long evenings to get to know our city. The Forks National Historic Site is a short walk away. The Forks has been a meeting place for centuries and remains a focal point in Winnipeg. You can take the river walk west along the Assiniboine River to the Manitoba Legislature or north up the Red River to the Esplanade Riel. Continue your walk to the other side of the Red River and visit western Canada's largest francophone community of Saint-Boniface where you can visit the childhood home of French Canadian literary icon Gabrielle Roy. The Exchange District is a fifteen minute walk away and contains one of the best concentrations of late 19th and early 20th century architecture to be found in any North American city. The area is also home to some of the best dining in the city. Consult the conference webpage for dining and excursion suggestions.

The entire 2014 conference planning committee is thrilled to be hosting CALL/ACBD 2014 and promises you a rewarding, memorable conference comprised of stimulating educational sessions, delightful social activities, and interesting sightseeing opportunities. Welcome to Winnipeg!
